



Instructions for use: Observe the following instructions in order to ensure your protection.

Endless welded band saw blades

Attention! Before handling the band saw blade, always wear **protective clothing** consisting of safety goggles, protective gloves, and safety shoes in order to prevent injuries, especially cuts from sharp tooth edges. If dust is generated during sawing, especially during a dry cut, wear a mask against in order to avoid health hazards resulting from inhaling dust.

Caution! If the packaging is damaged, also look for damage to the band saw blade (e.g., deformations, corrosions, and cracks). Such damage may cause the band saw blade to break. You should therefore not use damaged band saw blades.

Caution! The band saw blades are coated with corrosion protection. It is therefore advisable to wear gloves. In the case of skin contact with the corrosion protection, thoroughly wash the affected part of the body.

Danger! Packed band saw blades are under tension and can spring open when the fastening loops are opened. There is a risk of injury.

Attention! Store the band saw blade in a dry place. Otherwise, it can be damaged by corrosion.

Caution! Stacking band saw bands without tooth protection can damage them.

Caution! Do not remove the saw blade tooth guard until after the saw blade has been installed and tensioned in the machine; otherwise, there is a risk of cutting injuries.

Attention! Band saw blades can break during sawing operation. It is therefore essential to read the operating instructions of the machine manufacturer before starting work.

Attention! When using the saw, heat generation is possible as are flying chips, sparks, and splinters. You should therefore wear the appropriate protective clothing.

Attention! The coating of the diamond band saw blades contains nickel. Avoid direct skin contact if you are allergic to nickel. You should also wear suitable gloves.

Band saw coils for band saw blades

Attention! Before handling band saw coils, always wear **protective clothing** consisting of safety goggles, protective gloves, and safety shoes in order to prevent injuries, especially cuts from sharp tooth edges.

Caution! If the packaging is damaged, also look for damage to the band saw coils (e.g., deformations, corrosions, and cracks). Do not use damaged band saw coils. Damaged band saw coils can break when used as a band saw blade.

Caution! The band saw coils are coated with corrosion protection. It is therefore advisable to wear gloves. In the case of skin contact with the corrosion protection, thoroughly wash the affected part of the body.

Danger! Packaged band saw coils are under tension. You should therefore not remove the lid of the package.

Attention! Pull the band saw coils out of the packaging at the open corner. There is a risk of injury from sharp teeth and edges.

Attention! Keep the band saw coils dry (risk of corrosion).

Attention when using as a band saw blade! Observe the instructions at the very top under "Instructions for use for endless welded band saw blades."

Circular saw blades

Attention! Before handling band saw coils, always wear **protective clothing** consisting of safety goggles, protective gloves, and safety shoes in order to prevent injuries, especially cuts from sharp tooth edges.

Attention! Keep the circular saw blades dry (risk of corrosion).

Attention! Stack circular saw blades only in the packaging provided for this purpose. Otherwise, the teeth may be damaged. Caution! The circular saw blade is coated with anti-corrosion protection.

Attention! When removing the circular saw blade, there is a risk of injury from sharp teeth and edges. If the packaging is damaged, check for damage to the circular saw blade.

Attention! Do not use damaged circular saw blades (e.g., with cracks, deformations, corrosion, or damaged teeth). Damaged circular saw blades can break during use.

Attention! During use, heat development is possible as are flying chips, sparks, and splinters. Make sure to wear protective equipment.

Attention! When dry cutting, wear a mask in order to prevent the inhalation of dust.

Attention! Circular saw blades can break. The operating instructions of the machine manufacturer must be observed.
